

THE PAMPAS OF SOUTH AMERICA

The Pampas is a grassy plain ecosystem that covers 295,000 miles of central Argentina from the Atlantic coast to the foothills of the Andes Mountains.



CLIMATE: Avg. Temp:
64° F

Western Dry Zone: large fields, sandy deserts, and brackish streams

Eastern Humid Zone: more water sources here

Seasons: Opposite of N. Hemisphere; Summers are warm, and last from late December through late March. Winters are mostly temperate, and last from late June to September.
